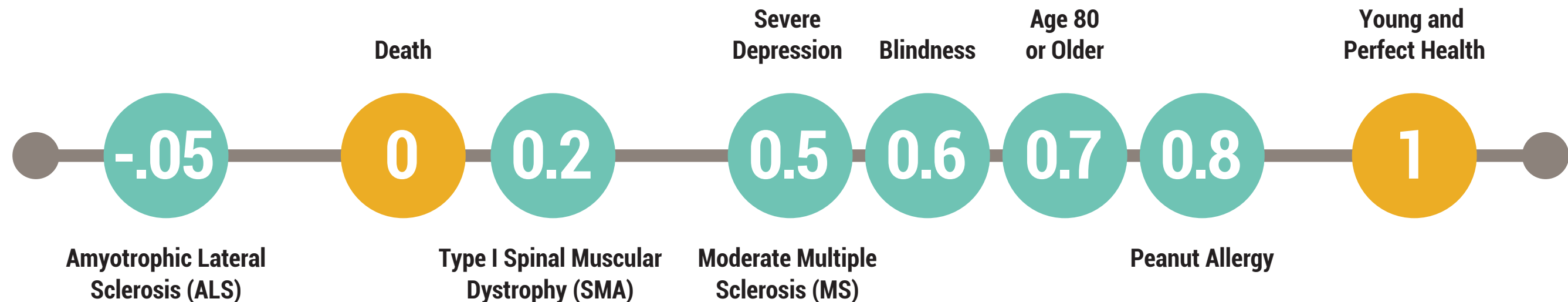

QALY Health Utilities

Quality-adjusted life years, or QALYs, is a metric commonly used to determine the value of a health care treatment. To calculate a QALY, you must assign a value to a person's life. Because the value assigned to seniors, the chronically ill, or people with disabilities is lower than that of a young, healthy person, QALYs could lead policymakers and payers to conclude that treatments for seniors, patients with chronic conditions or people with disabilities are not worth covering.
